SCRIPT II:

Little Rooster's Diamond Button (A kiskakas gyémánt félkrajcárja)

characters: narrator (N), woman (W), little rooster (LR), Turkish sultan (S)

Start signal: Magyar népmesék music played

1. The village scene

(scene of a Hungarian village projected into the background on a screen)

N: Somewhere ... someplace ... across the seven seas ... there lived a little old woman and her pet rooster.

One day, little rooster was pecking around for something to eat. He pecked and pecked and he pecked up a diamond button.

LR: "Cock-a-doodle-doo! Cock-a-doodle-doo! I'll take this home to my good mistress. She likes diamond buttons."

2. The palace scene

(During the scene folk dancers in folk costumes dance sárközi style in the background)

- S: "Take that diamond button! Put it in my treasure chamber!"
- N: Little Rooster flew right to the king's palace.
- LR: "Cock-a-doodle-doo! Cock-a-doodle-doo! Give me back my diamond button"
- S: "Throw that little rooster into the well!"
- LR: "Come my empty stomach! Come my empty stomach! Drink up all the water in the well!" "Cock-a-doodle-doo! Cock-a-doodle-doo! Give me back my diamond button"
- S: Throw that little rooster into the fire!"
- LR: "Come my full stomach! Come my full stomach! Spit out all the water from the well and put out the fire!"
- LR: "Cock-a-doodle-doo! Cock-a-doodle-doo! Give me back my diamond button"
- S: Throw that little rooster into a beehive! Let the bees sting him!"
- LR: "Come my empty stomach! Come my empty stomach! Eat up all the bees."

N: And the little rooster and his good mistress lived richly and happily ever after.
